Dr. Sodicoff: That's one of the best things about the whole thing. Is taking meds away from people. People don't want to be on medications. People can't even afford their medicines.

I mean in this country it's a problem, insulin is very expensive. I just had a guy in the hospital, he was a type 1, and he couldn't afford his diabetes meds. And he came in DKA. So if he's on a keto diet it's possible that type 1s will never go without insulin, but he could be spending a lot less money.

Dr. Eenfeldt: Maybe half, maybe a third.

Dr. Sodicoff: Maybe half, maybe a third, yeah.

Dr. Eenfeldt: That's a lot of money saved if it's expensive.

Dr. Sodicoff: It's expensive in this country, so... It's a shame, but--

Dr. Eenfeldt: It's just one more benefit then... Save money.

Dr. Sodicoff: Absolutely.
