**Ivor Cummins:** If you don't measure it, it don't get fixed. And the whole problem in our medical business today I think and I certainly got to refer to the lack of measurements in insulin and post-prandial insulin, that's a huge problem.

But I will show you a measurement that's grossly underused. And the measurement is the CT scan of the heart, coronary calcium. On the left you see our sprightly Jeff there at 54 or 55 five and in the green circle you can see in his scan he had zero calcium in his coronary arteries.

That's a 15 year warranty for a middle-aged person. Your event rates will be so low with a zero in the following decades relatively. It's called a human warranty. On the right we see a guy with probably a score of 600, 700. Left anterior descending, all chopped up. That's a high-risk person.
